If your filming application is approved, you will be responsible for crew inductions and you may be required to manage a number of sensitive issues relating to the use of this significant heritage site.

I / We agree that by being granted permission to film or record within the Fremantle Prison precinct, I / we undertake:

- To respect the highly significant cultural history and built heritage fabric of Fremantle Prison, and not to depict the Prison or anything associated with it in a manner that is derogatory or demeaning in any way;
- To cooperate with and abide by instructions given by Fremantle Prison personnel at all times;
- To not disrupt the normal operating activities and tours of Fremantle Prison and undertake the filming within the scope of the project and timeframe agreed with Fremantle Prison;
- To not shift or remove any material without the express written approval of Fremantle Prison personnel;
- To not damage the building/s or materials; and to pay for any damages or costs incurred by Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage as a result of filming;
- To not affix or attach any props, backdrops, lighting or any other item to the buildings, walls and fixtures within the Prison precinct;
- To take all reasonable precautions to ensure a safe working environment for all people associated with the filming and for the security of equipment and personal property of participants whilst on site; and
- To discharge Fremantle Prison, the State of Western Australia and its respective servants and agents, to the extent permitted by law, from any claims for loss, damage or injury arising from this filming.
